**Discuss PY'21 Priorities**......**Mr. Holloway** In alignment with the Committee's Charter, Mr. Holloway recommended four priorities for the Committee's consideration: create labor market information training for board members; distribute relevant publications for awareness and strategic planning; provide opportunities for showcasing local innovation; and conduct an economic and workforce analysis. The Committee also discussed the importance of exposing youth to career opportunities. No additional priorities were identified.
