• SWDB and LWDB joint trainings, meetings, and information sessions:

Members proposed joint trainings and meeting opportunities, including inviting LWDB members to the Third Annual Workforce Champion Award Ceremony on September 16, 2025, and the 2025 Workforce Development Symposium on September 17, 2025. Other joint training and meeting topics proposed included continuing to include local members in the Annual Ethics Training, hosting an in-person luncheon annually, and adding discussions around bigpicture issues such as 'AI & How it's Going to Affect the Workforce'.
